The Heart & Hand Community Services Center in Putnam County is now providing free diapers and formula to families in need.

There are no income guidelines and families are supplied with enough diapers and formula to adequately meet the needs of each child for each week.

The only request for this service is proof of a state issued birth certificate for each child being served. If this is not available or the family does not have one, a short application to request a copy is available at the Center. This is **FREE** of charge!

The Heart & Hand Community Services Center is also able to help with many other needs: utility assistance, processing Dollar Energy applications, and coordinating services with other social service agencies and churches, just to name a few.
